

S.R. 349 Improvements

Lafayette County from the Dixie County line to U.S. 27



A Florida Department of Transportation project to resurface State Road 349 in Lafayette County, between the Dixie County line and U.S. 27, is scheduled to begin Monday, April 19.

PROJECT DETAILS

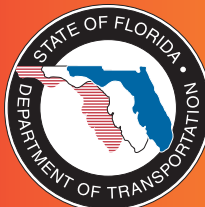
- The top 1.5 inches of asphalt will be removed and replaced and five-foot shoulders will be added.
- Drainage pipes beneath some driveways will be replaced.
- Lane closures will occur from 7 a.m. to dusk, Mondays through Thursdays, and on Fridays when necessary.
- When entering the road from a driveway or side street during lane closures, watch for traffic heading in the same direction before pulling out to avoid driving into oncoming traffic.
- Drainage work will begin at the Dixie County line, followed by shoulder construction and roadway paving.
- Anderson Columbia Company of Lake City has been hired to complete the work for \$2.9 million in about six months, weather permitting.
- Approximately 2,300 vehicles per day travel this section of roadway, which was last resurfaced in 1991.

Please Note ...

All mailboxes, along the 8.7-mile project limits of S.R. 349, will be removed and replaced with new mailboxes that meet current safety standards.

The contractor will place the old mailbox on the ground near the new mailbox and leave it there for five days. To keep the old mailbox, pick it up within the five days or the contractor will dispose of it.
