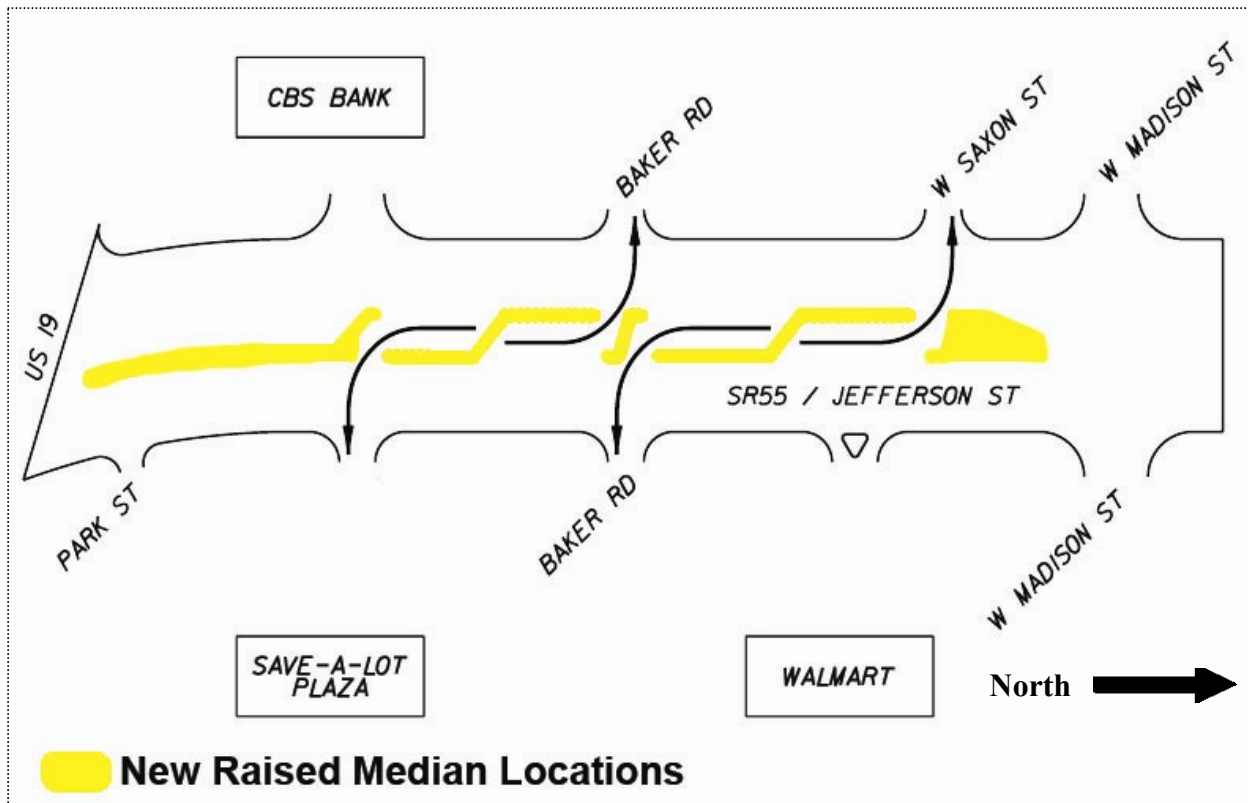


# Safety Improvements Planned

## *Raised Median Construction*

### U.S. 221 (Jefferson Street)

#### *Perry-Taylor County*



Raised medians will be built along U.S. 221 (Jefferson Street) from U.S. 19 north to West Madison Street (Wal-Mart Entrance). This project will reduce traffic conflicts and left turn and angle crashes along this portion of Jefferson Street. Median openings will be provided in various locations so motorists have access to business. These include:

- A northbound, left turn opening will be provided at West Saxon Street which will also be used for northbound motorists to make a legal U-turn.
- A northbound, left turn opening will be provided at Baker Road.
- A southbound, left turn opening will be provided at Baker Road.
- Pending approval, a southbound left turn opening will be provided at the main entrance for the Save-A-Lot Plaza. The driveway will also be reconstructed at the Save-A-Lot Plaza.
- A southbound, left turn lane with a raised median will be constructed for U.S. 221 motorists turning south onto U.S. 19
- With the construction of the raised medians, left turns will be eliminated when exiting Hardees, Baker Road, West Saxon Street, Save-A-Lot Plaza and Park Street.
